

ORDINANCE NUMBER 119
BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, on August 27, 1979, Virgil Stackhouse, made application for an amendment of Ordinance Number 114, the Benton County Zoning Map, requesting that the property hereinafter described be rezoned from "R-2" Single Family Residence to Business District "B"; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 1979 and September 26, 1979, a Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official newspaper and mailed to the governing bodies of all towns and municipalities located within Benton County; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 1979, and October 2, 1979, a public hearing concerning said application was conducted by a majority of the members of the planning commission and the county board; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 1979, the planning commission recommended that said land be rezoned as requested,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the county board of Benton County that Ordinance Number 114 (Benton County Zoning Map) be and hereby is amended as follows:

The following described property situated in the County of Benton and State of Minnesota, is rezoned Business District "B":


All of Government Lot Five (5) except the East 435 feet and the West 220 feet, all in Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-eight (38) North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, Langola Township, Benton County, Minnesota.
