

ORDINANCE NUMBER 130

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission instituted action for an amendment of Ordinance Number 114 (the Benton County Zoning Map) and Ordinance Number 123 requesting that the property hereinafter described be rezoned from Heavy Industrial District "I-2" to Agricultural District "A-1"; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1980, a Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official newspaper and mailed to the governing bodies of all towns and municipalities located within Benton County; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1980, a public hearing was conducted by a majority of the members of the Planning Commission and the Ordinance was recommended for passage; and


WHEREAS, on October 21, 1980, the County Board conducted a public hearing thereon, and on November 4, 1980, the Ordinance was recommended for passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Benton County that Ordinance Number 114 (Benton County Zoning Map) and Ordinance Number 123 be and hereby are amended as follows:

The following described property situated in the County of Benton and State of Minnesota, is zoned Agricultural District "A-1":

Starting at a point on the Southeast corner of the North One-half of the Northwest Quarter (N 1/2 of NW 1/4) of Section Two (2), Township Thirty-six (36) North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, Sauk Rapids Township, Benton County, Minnesota; thence Northerly along the East line for a distance of 933 feet; thence Westerly and at right angles a distance of 933 feet; thence Southerly and at right angles a distance of 933 feet to a point on the South line of said North One-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2; thence Easterly along the South line a distance of 933 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating. Said tract containing 20 acres, more or less.
