

ORDINANCE NUMBER 133

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the County of Benton is empowered by law to acquire land for park purposes and to maintain and operate same; and

WHEREAS, the County of Benton has acquired land and developed and maintains a public park known as Benton Beach, which land is situated on Little Rock Lake in Langola Township, Benton County, Minnesota, and is legally described as follows:

Commencing at the northeasterly corner of Government Lot Five (5) in Section Thirty-Five (35), Township Thirty-Eight (38), North, Range Thirty-One (31) West; thence south approximately 33 feet to the southerly boundary line of C.S.A.H. Number 2 for the point of beginning; thence right angles west 435 feet; thence at right angles south and parallel with the east boundary line of Government Lot Five (5) approximately 1406 feet to the shoreline of Little Rock Lake; thence in a northeasterly direction along the shore of Little Rock Lake to the easterly boundary line of said Government Lot Five (5); thence north along the east boundary line of said Government Lot Five (5) to the point of beginning; all subject to flowage easement of record.

AND WHEREAS, past experience has shown that the park has been misused late at night disturbing neighbors in the vicinity and those who have registered with the caretaker for overnight camping,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS that Benton Beach shall be closed to the public during the hours of 10:30 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. daily except for those persons who register in advance with the caretaker for overnight camping.

Violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a sentence of not more than 90 days in jail or a fine of not more than \$500.00 or both.
