

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the Benton County Planning Commission on its own motion instituted proceedings to amend Section 11.3.2 of Ordinance Number 113, the Benton County Development Code; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 1982, Notice of Intent to Amend the Benton County Development Code and Notice of Public Hearings thereon was published in the official newspaper; and

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1982, the planning commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended same to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval and passage; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1982, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing thereon and approved the proposed zoning amendment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Commissioners that Section 11.3.2 of Ordinance Number 113 (Benton County Development Code) be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

11.3.2 Membership

The planning commission shall be composed of eleven (11) members. Each member shall be appointed by the county board.

There shall be one member from Commissioner District Four (4) and one member from Commissioner District Five (5). The remaining nine members shall be residents of County Commissioner Districts One, Two and Three. The County Commissioner from the applicable district will recommend to the county board a nominee or nominees from the district for planning commission membership.


The County Board shall, in certain instances, require that two or more townships share a planning commission representative in order to limit the commission membership to the eleven maximum allowable. The actual allocation of planning commission representatives among and between the twelve townships shall be by county board resolution.
