WHEREAS, on January 24, 1984, Travelers Advertising Company made application for an amendment of Ordinance Number 113 (Section 9.1.5(b) of the Benton County Development Code); and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 1984, Notice of Public Hearings and Request to Amend Benton County Development Code was published in the official newspaper; and

WHEREAS, on February 16, 1984, the planning commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended same to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval and passage; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 1984, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing thereon and on March 6, 1984 approved the proposed zoning amendment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Commissioners that Ordinance Number 113 (Section 9.1.5(b) of the Benton County Development Code) be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

9.1.5 Advertising Signs (Billboards)

- (b) Advertising signs shall not be less than 500 feet apart on the same side of the road.
