

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, on May 23, 1985, Emil Kelm, Jr.; Louis J. Reed and Leona A. Bartfeit ETAL, & Irene Heathcock; made application for an amendment of Ordinance Number 131, the Benton County Flood Boundary and Floodway Map, requesting that the property hereinafter described be rezoned from "Floodway" to "Flood Fringe"; and

WHEREAS, on July 3, 1985, a notice of public hearings was published in the official newspaper and mailed to the governing bodies of all towns and municipalities located within Benton County; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 1985, the planning commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended same to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval and passage; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 1985, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing thereon and approved the proposed zoning amendment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Benton County, Minnesota, that Ordinance Number 131 (Benton County Flood Boundary and Floodway Map) be and hereby is amended as follows, to-wit:

The following described property situated in the County of Benton and State of Minnesota is zoned "Flood Fringe":

That part of Government Lots Two (2) and Three (3) in Section Thirty-four (34), Township Thirty-seven (37) North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, Watab Township, Benton County, Minnesota, lying Easterly of the Shoreline of the Mississippi River, and Westerly of County Road Number 55, also lying between Survey Cross Sections D and F as identified on the Flood Boundary and Floodway Map, Community Panel Number 270019 - 0100B
