

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the Benton County Planning Commission on its own motion instituted proceedings to amend Ordinance Number 185 (Benton County Development Code), and any other ordinance, if any, amending Ordinance Number 185, to eliminate the minimum size requirement of 160 square feet for Advertising Signs (Billboards); and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 1990, Notice of Public Hearings and Intent to Amend Benton County Development Code was published in the official newspaper and mailed to the governing bodies of all towns and municipalities located within Benton County; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 1990, the planning commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended same to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval and passage; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 1990, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing thereon and approved the proposed zoning amendment,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BENTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ORDAINS:

Amend Section 9.1.5(a) of the Benton County Development Code, Advertising Signs (Billboards), to read as follows:

9.1.5 Advertising Signs (Billboards)

- (a) Advertising signs may be permitted as a Conditional Use in all Agricultural Districts and as a permitted use in all Business and Industrial Districts, providing they are not larger than 300 square feet.
