

BENTON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 326

WHEREAS, the Benton County Board of Commissioners instituted proceedings to amend Benton County Ordinance 185; and,

WHEREAS, on December 26, 2000, Notice of Public Hearing and intent to amend Benton County Ordinance 185, Section 3 was published in the official newspaper of the county; and,

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2001, the Benton County Planning Commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended same to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval and passage; and,


WHEREAS, on January 16, 2001, the Benton County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing and approved the proposed ordinance amendment; and,

NOW PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED BY MINNESOTA STATUTES SECTION 394.25, THE BENTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS: that Benton County Ordinance 185, Section 3 by adding the following definition:

Transfer Station: an intermediate solid waste disposal facility in which solid waste collected from any source is temporarily deposited to await transportation to another solid waste management facility. This process must take place inside of a building.


This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
