


# Measles

IT ISN'T JUST A LITTLE RASH

Measles can be dangerous, especially for children.

## MEASLES SYMPTOMS TYPICALLY INCLUDE

- High fever (may spike to more than 104° F)
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Red, watery eyes
- Rash breaks out 3-5 days after symptoms begin



- Make sure your family gets the MMR vaccine (measles, mumps, rubella).
- The MMR vaccine is safe.
- Research has proven ***no association*** between MMR vaccine and autism.
- Vaccine refusal contributes to outbreaks.
