

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

NORTHEAST Corner of Section 29, Township 38 N, Range 31 W
4th Principal Meridian, State of Minnesota, County of BENTON

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On 11/10/2000 found a STANDARD BENTON COUNTY CAST IRON MONUMENT, DOWN 0.2'
DATE WITH THE TOP CAP OF THE MONUMENT BROKEN OFF.
- left monument as found lowered monument removed monument (explain)
- On 11/24/2000 placed a 1/8" DRILL HOLE IN THE CENTER OF THE REMAINING CIM
DATE THE TOP OF THE BROKEN CIM IS DOWN 0.4'

Statement of Evidence

Northeast Corner of Section 29, Twp. 38 N, Rng. 31 W
4th P.M., Benton County, Minnesota

Copies of notes from the original GLO survey, located in the office of the Benton County Highway Department, state that a wood post in a mound was set to mark the corner with a pit 8 links East.

April 1930; Road plans for County Project 3006 by H. G. Elletson shows a P. I. in the roadway alignment near the location of the corner. There is no mention of the corner or a monument marking the corner.

July 1969; Notes from a survey by M. Carley / M.B. Lang, Job 69-214, page 130, on file in the office of David Regan PLS, specify the corner as an "I M Inpl." Other surveys of Section 28-38-31 by M. Carley / M.B. Lang that were performed in 1966 and 1977 refer to this corner, but do not specify a type of monument.

March 1971; William Lunser, RLS #9394, found a 1/2" iron pipe inplace. A Certificate of Location of Government Corner was filed with the office of the Benton County Highway Department.

May 1983; Lunser's 1971 certificate was updated by placing a Benton County cast iron monument inplace of the 1/2" iron pipe. Revision notes were made on Lunser's 1971 certificate.


November 2000; Sam DeLeo, RLS #40341, found a standard Benton County cast iron monument 0.2' below the bituminous surface of CR 2. The top cap of the CIM was inplace, but broken off. The top cap was removed and a 1/8" hole was drilled into the top center of the remaining CIM base. New reference ties were recorded and a new Certificate of Location of Government Corner was made.


