

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast corner, Section 4, T38N, R30 W, 4th P.M.

During th G.L.O. Survey of 1858, Wilbur F. Duffy, a U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a wooden post to mark this corner

In 1984, Paul E. Wellen, L.L.S., St. Cloud, Minnesota, excavated this area and could not find any evidence of this corner and set a Cast Iron Monument in the center line of a north-south township road at the intersection of fence line to the east.
