

The East Quarter Corner of Section 29, Township 38 North, Range 28 West, Granite Ledge Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

In 1855 a wood post was set, by Oscar F. Davis, at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

9" Maple	S 84 E	30 links
8" I. Wood	N 66 W	12 links

The County Surveyors records in Book 2, page 366 show an iron pipe with the following reference ties dated 1962.

F.P.	E	32.8
F.P.	NE	62.9
T.P.	NW	82.2
P.P.	SE	54.3

On October 3, 2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a 1/2" open iron monument over a 1" solid pin at the intersection of the centerlines of Township Road 67 (running north and south) and 130<sup>th</sup> Street NE (running from the west). We also checked for ties and found 1 tie that fit from 1962 (PP SE 54.22). We removed the 1/2" open iron monument and placed a cast iron monument over the 1" solid pin at the location of the corner and established reference ties.
