

North Quarter Corner of Section 12, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4th Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

18" Aspen	S 40 E	9 links
14" Aspen	S 65 W	4 links

1991 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a cast iron monument at a fence corner running east/west/south. He considered the fences as evidence of the obliterated position and filed a Certificate of Location (#234190). He notes a distance of 2648.97 feet to the NW corner and a distance of 2646.47 feet to the NE corner of Sec 12. He notes corner is 55 feet north of a straight line between section corners.

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2008 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument at the intersection of fences east/west/south. Measured 2647.25 feet to the NW corner and 2646.54 feet to the NE corner of Section 12. Position falls 52 feet north of a straight line between section corners but east/west position fit well to a lost position. Cast iron monument fits longstanding occupation and is accepted as marking the obliterated position for this corner.



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE:

No records were found to indicate use or remonumentation of this corner after its original placement by the U.S. Government Survey (G.L.O.).

A search of the area revealed no monument in place. A long standing fence corner with fences running east, west and south and occupation to the north coincide within acceptable limits of the G.L.O.'s east-west position for the quarter corner. However, the G.L.O.'s north-south position falls 55 feet south of the fence corner.

A field road along the north line of the SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 2, serving farm land to the north, begins 9 feet north of the northeast corner of said SE1/4 SE1/4 and runs to a point 38 feet north of the northwest corner thereof as determined by the G.L.O. position. By using the fence corner at the quarter corner the 38 foot is reduced to 24 feet.

The corner was therefor considered obliterated by the erection of fences, which were taken as accessories to the original post.
