

Statement of Evidence:

The North Quarter Corner of Section 7, Township 37 North, Range 28 West, Maywood Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

In July of 1855, Oscar F. Davis set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

7" I. Wood S 4 E 20 links
8" Elm N 12 E 20 links

The County Surveyors records in Book 2, page 396, show the following B.T.

8" Burr Oak W 36 1/2 E 64 links

On December 26, 1995 William Lunser found a 1/2" iron pipe of unknown origin that coincides with lines of occupation consisting of fence lines north and south and a township road east and west. Reference ties were established. A Certificate of Location (#234178) was filed.

On September 9, 2000 Westwood Wellen Services found a 1/2" iron pipe at the corner location.

On October 22, 2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a 1/2" open at the intersection of the centerline of 105th Street NE (running east and west) and fence lines (running north and south). Removed the 1/2" open and placed a cast iron monument at the location and established new ties.



No records were found to indicate use or remonumentation of this corner after its original placement by the U.S. Government Survey.

A search of the area revealed a 1/2 inch iron pipe of unknown origin which coincides with lines of occupation consisting of fence lines north and south and a township road east and west.

After comparing measured distances to those of the G.L.O. I consider this monument to be the best evidence of the original corner.
