

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner Section 3, Township 36 North, Range 31 West.

Theodore Conkey and John Ryan ran the original public land surveys in 1849 and 1850. A wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to a 6" black oak tree and three bur oak trees 6" to 12" in diameter.

A survey by Benton County done in approximately 1915 titled "Survey #1, State Road #1" shows an iron monument being set and ties being made.

In the 1960's Mn/ Dot survey crews found and surveyed a 14" x 5/8" bolt in the center of the township road. Mn/DOT survey crews replaced this bolt in 1968 with a cast iron monument and ties made after construction of TH 10 and the obliteration of the old township roadway.

On August 12, 1982 RLS David P. Regan, RLS found a Mn/DOT cast iron monument. He made ties to it and filed a certificate, Doc. #163374.

On January 6, 1999 Mn/Dot survey crews found a Mn/DOT cast iron monument in accordance with Regan's certificate. Ties to the monument were updated at this time. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts the position of the found Mn/DOT cast iron monument as the correct location for the corner.


