

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

- A line tree was noted as a 8" Tamarac East 9.24 chains and a 6" Tamarac West 18.96 chains.
- 1930 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 145, contains a survey by H. G. Elletson, which shows the corner being a granite monument.
- Pre 1940 MN/DOT notes by C. H. West for TH 95 show square stone monument on proposed centerline.
- 1972 John Oliver, LS 8194, Sherburne County Surveyor, found granite monument at the corner, took ties, and filed a Certificate of Location in Sherburne County.
- 2000 Sherburne County Surveyor's Office found 6" x 6" granite monument, took new ties and prepare new Certificate of Location.
