

The East Quarter Corner of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 32 West, West Langola Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office surveyor, Edwin James, Jr., set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

12" Bur Oak	N 1/2 W	110 links
16" Bur Oak	East	147 links

1979 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, set a cast iron monument on a fence line east/west/south and filed a Certificate of Location (#155145). This corner is 5286.04 west of the E 1/4 Corner of Section 4.

2008 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument fitting 1979 Wellen ties with fence lines running east/west/south. Measured 5285.68 feet to the E1/4 of Section 4 and 2641.94 feet to the NE corner of Section 5 which is consistent with GLO measurements. Searched the area for any sign of the original bearing trees and found no conclusive evidence. Cast iron monument is accepted as marking the obliterated position for this corner.


