

BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, on June 18, 1984, Kathleen Appert made application for an amendment of Ordinance Numbers 113, 118, 125, 127, 128, 129 and 138 (Sections 7.1.4 and 7.2.3 of the Benton County Development Code); and

WHEREAS, on July 4, 1984, Notice of Public Hearings and Request to Amend Benton County Development Code was published in the official newspaper; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 1984, the planning commission held a public hearing thereon and recommended same to the Benton County Board of Commissioners for approval and passage; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 1984, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing thereon and approved the proposed zoning amendment,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BENTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS as follows:

I

Add to the Development Code, Ordinance Number 113, the following section to read as follows:

- 3.120(1) Recreational Facility: Bowling alley, cart track, golf course, pool hall, vehicle/animal racing or amusement, dance hall, skating, tavern, theater, firearms range, campgrounds, and similar uses.

II


That Section 7.1.4 of Ordinance Numbers 113, 118, 125, 127, 128 and 129 be amended to add as a Conditional Use in "A-1" Districts the following: "recreational facilities, providing that they comply with Section 7.1.2(a), (b) and (c) of the Development Code and that they are at least a half-mile from an existing feedlot".

III

That Section 7.2.3 of Ordinance Numbers 113, 118, 125, 127, 128, 129 and 138 be amended to add as a Conditional Use in "A-2" Districts the following: "recreational facilities, providing that they comply with Section 7.1.2(a), (b) and (c) of the Development Code and that they are at least a half-mile from an existing feedlot".
